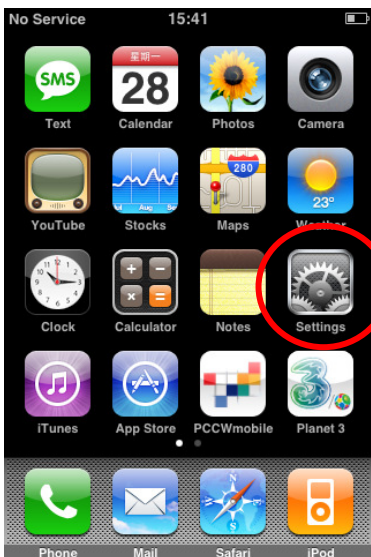


## Apple iPhone3G Wi-Fi Browsing User Guide

### Smart Tips:

- If you want to use Wi-Fi for browsing, make sure you have Wi-Fi indicator while browsing and stay under Wi-Fi coverage
- If moving out of a Wi-Fi coverage, handsets will auto connect to GPRS

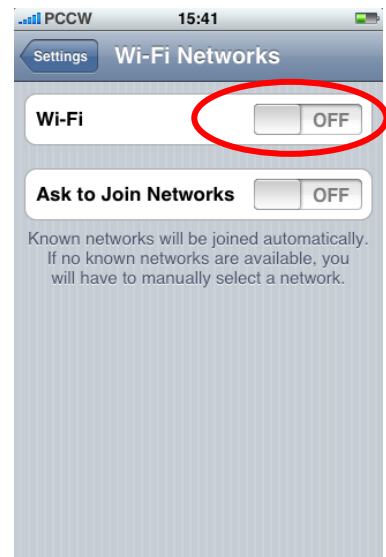
### Setup for Wi-Fi browsing:



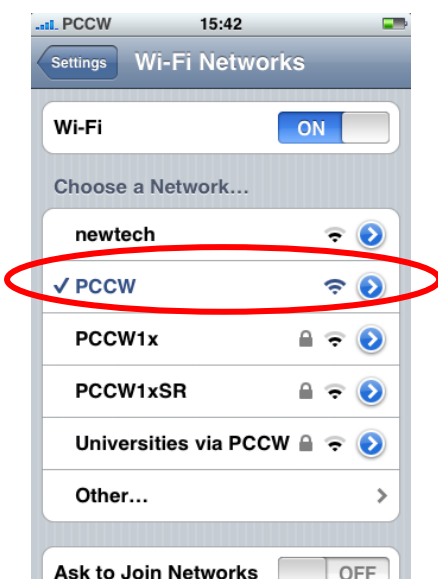
1. At idle screen > go to "Settings"



2. Click on "Wi-Fi"



3. Switch on Wi-Fi



4. Select your AP (Access Point).

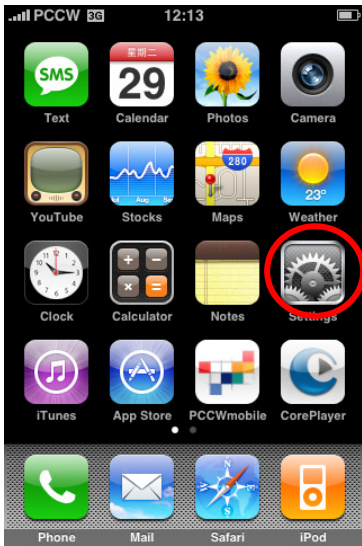


5. Go to browser, you will see the Wi-Fi icon is on and you are using Wi-Fi as data connection

**Disconnect a GPRS connection:**

Method 1: Turn off the iPhone

Method 2: Remove APN setting



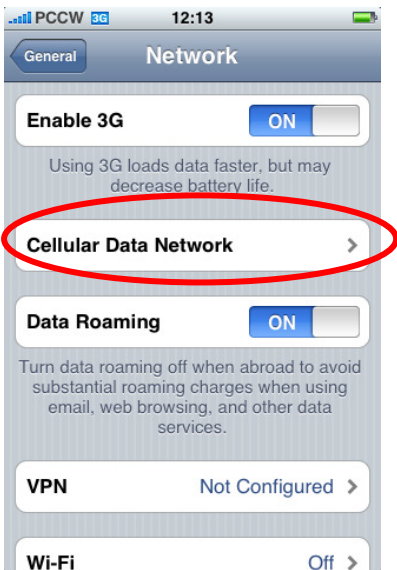
1. Go to "Settings"



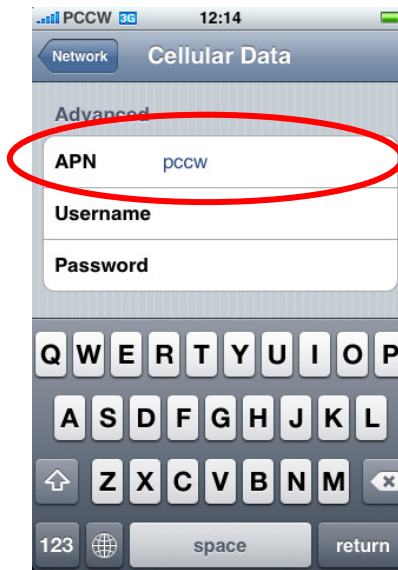
2. Click on "General"



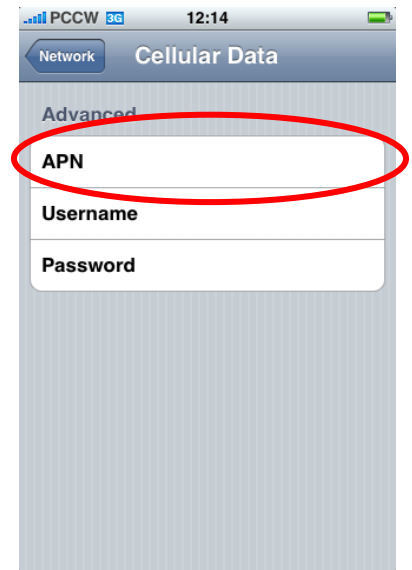
3. Go to "Network"



4. Access "Cellular Data Network"



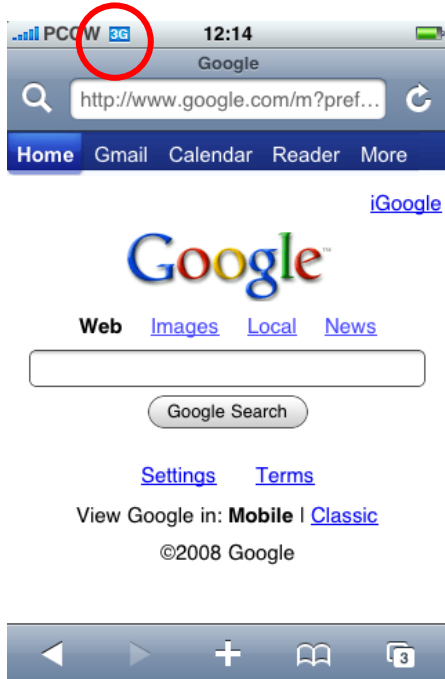
5. Go to the "APN" field



6. Leave the APN as blank

### FAQ:

Q: When will it use Wi-Fi for data connection?

A: iPhone3G default setting is to use Wi-Fi as priority for data connection, please make sure you are under Wi-Fi coverage. If you move out from a Wi-Fi coverage, handset will auto connect to GPRS but it will not re-connect to Wi-Fi even you move back to Wi-Fi coverage area.

Q: How to confirm I am under Wi-Fi coverage?

A: As handset will auto detect for Wi-Fi network for every minute, if you see the handset is connected to GPRS (with 3G icon), please disconnect it and move back to Wi-Fi coverage area.
